#### 1.1 Faculty Overview

Faculty of Business Studies consists of seven Departments, namely, Department of Finance and Accountancy, the Department of Business Economics, Department of Human Resource Management, Department Management and Entrepreneurship, Department of Marketing Management, Department of Project Management, and the Department of English Language Teaching. In the Faculty of Business Studies, initially three-year Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree was offered and, now, both three and four-year Bachelor of **Business** Management (BBM) degrees are offered for students.

The Faculty offers Bachelor of Business Management (BBM) honours degree programme, namely, Accounting and Finance, Marketing Management, **Business Economics** Human and Resource Management and **Project** Management. Further. the faculty introduced two new honours degree programs in Banking and Insurance and Entrepreneurship. The students will be admitted to those new degree programs from 2021/2022 intake. The present student population of the faculty is about 1000.


#### 3.5.5 Launch of Silver Jubilee Video

- ➤ T-Shirt Launching of the PM Club



#### 3.8.11 International Project Management Day Celebration





# 10.1 Bachelor of Business Management Honours in Banking and Insurance

The Department of Finance and Accountancy obtained the approval for the commencement of the new degree programme, Bachelor of Business Management Honours in Banking and Insurance. To be eligible for admission to the course of study in BBM honours in Banking and Insurance, a candidate should have followed Accounting and Economics and the remaining subjects from any of the accepted subjects within the commerce stream.

# 10.2 Bachelor of Business Management in Entrepreneurship

The Department of Management and Entrepreneurship obtained the approval for the commencement of the new degree programme, Bachelor of Business Management Honours in Entrepreneurship. The students will be admitted by the University Grants Commission as the usual intake for the Faculty of Business Studies under the "Management TV" (TV: Trincomalee and Vavuniya)

# 10.3 Introducing the Master of Business Administration Program

The faculty has appointed the curriculum development committee and progressing to develop the MBA curriculum.

# 10.4 Introducing the Master Program in Project Management

The faculty has appointed the curriculum development committee and began to progress on meetings to develop the MPM curriculum.

# 10.5 Commencing the Higher National Diploma in English Language Program

The two-year Higher Diploma in English Extension English program was developed by the English Language Teaching Department and approved by the Council at its 4th Meeting. This proposed curriculum was prepared for 60 credits according to the SLQF Standards for Level Four. This program will benefit the region to train professionals in the English language and literature. The programme will be commenced shortly.

## 10.6 Signing of MOU with Ayodhya Research Institute, India

Initiatives are being taking place to sign a MOU with the Ayodhya Research Institute, India. This initiative will help the faculty to improve their academics and students on research writings and will open many avenues for research collaborations and publications.

#### 10.7 Commencement of Youth Leadership Program

The collaborations between the Faculty of Business Studies and UNDP has been established. As a result of this, the Youth Leadership Programmes are being planned to be held by January 2023. This Leadership Programme will be started in many universities including University of Vavuniya, University of Jaffna, Eastern University, Trinco Campus. Through this programme it is being expected to empower the youths.

The faculty has decided to introduce department-level conferences and journals to promote research culture among faculty staff and expand the research network with external institutions.
