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



There was a considerable level of participation from internal as well as external. The ultimate objective of conducting such photography competitions is to motivate the youth and encourage creativity.




ONLINEQUIZ COMPETITION

An ONLINE QUIZ COMPETITION was arranged by the Project Management Club of the Faculty of Business Studies at the University of Vavuniya for all first-, second-, and third-year students reading Project Management Degree Programme. The competition was held using university LMS. Following days were the competition was held

1st year students - 21/05/2022 2nd year students - 26/05/2022 3rd year students - 27/05/2022

Three winners were chosen from each batch based on their scores. S. Sasikumar achieved the first place from first-year students (2019/2020) with a score of 82.5, while M. Dishan and K. A. A. N. Kiththanpahuwa won second and third places, respectively, with the similar grade of 77.5.

D.Srikandaraja, a student in the second-year batch (2018/2019), won first place by scoring 83.6, followed by S. Yadharshika and T. Tharan, who have got second and third places respectively, with the scores of 79.6 and 75.6. from the third-year (2017/2018), A.A. Fathima Haseefa won first place with the highest score of 100, while Z. Farook and S. Rajini both scored 88 occupying the second place. The winners have been declare on 31st May 2022.


PROJECT MANAGEMENT COMPETENCIES FOR SUSTAINABLE PROFESSIONAL EVALUATION




Among other clubs in the university project management club was win the 1st place in the inter club competitions which held in the university.


