



Establishment of Five New Departments

The Departments of Economics and Management had proposed to establish five new departments by abolishing the existing ones to the UGC, letter dated on 12.12.2018, after the approval of the Council at its 430^{th} meeting held on 26.08.2018. As per the gazette notification of 2220/20 dated on 22.03.2021, the following five new departments have been established in the Faculty of Business Studies of the Vavuniya Campus of the University of Jaffna by abolishing the Department of Economics and Management.

- Department of Marketing Management
- Department of Business Economics
- Department of Human Resource Management
- Department of Management and Entrepreneurship
- Department of Project Management

Accounting and Finance Club - ACC Vision: Improve the organizational legitimacy via increasing the participation of the Accounting and Finance students in community outreach activities.




The release of the Journal of Business Management (JBM)




